Participants may decide to continue study, advancing to a diploma level qualification

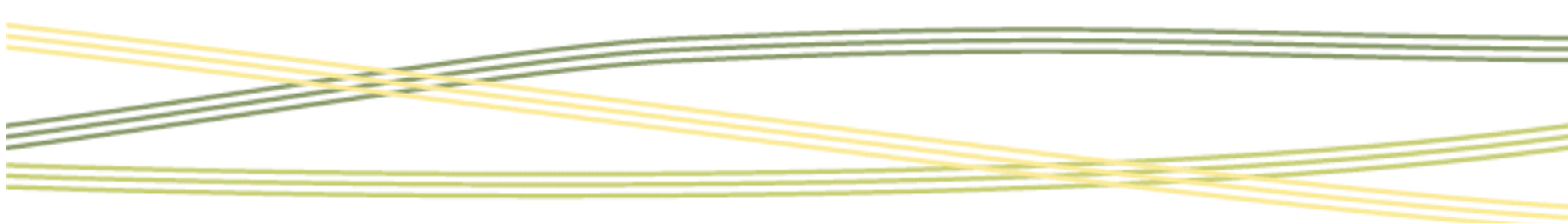
Assessment
